**TMPA'S RESPONSES TO JOINT PARTIES'
THIRD REQUEST FOR INFORMATION**

JP-TMPA 3-12.

If TMPA is designated to construct the CTP Facilities that it is proposing to build, are further approvals by TMPA, the four member cities, any other governmental authority, or the citizens of the four member cities necessary before TMPA can commit to construct such Facilities? Provide all documents or communications that discuss, address, or relate to any additional approvals that are necessary before TMPA can commit to construct the CTP Facilities it proposes to build.

RESPONSE:

The TMPA Board of Directors will make a decision whether TMPA should be committed before a final decision is made by the PUCT in this docket. After the PUCT makes a final decision, TMPA will be committed to construct the CTP Facilities. Thereafter, in the implementation of that commitment, the TMPA Board of Directors will take various actions such as, for example, adopting or amending capital budgets to accommodate the CTP Facilities, approving construction contracts, and approving financing for CTP Facilities.
